Additional information:

- Candidates must be the nominated Delegate of the Voting Member organisation in order to nominate for a Director's position. If you are unsure if you are the Delegate, please contact the Returning Officer.
- An organisation must be in the 'consumer organisation' category to nominate a Director for the Consumer Member position. (Please note the Carer Member position will be open for election in 2020.)
- Voting Members can vote on nominations for all positions in a contested election. If there are less than or equal nominees to the number of vacancies, candidates are automatically appointed as elected directors.
- The Board meets 6-8 times per year in Canberra and by teleconference. Travel expenses (i.e. flights, accommodation and meals) are paid for by Mental Health Australia.
- The Chair and the Directors nominated by the Consumer Members and Consumer Members may receive an annual honorarium. The amount of any honorarium is to be determined by the Board every year.
- Three Elected Directors with the highest number of votes will be appointed to the two year terms. (The Consumer Member position is outside of this process and will be the usual two year term.)
- Board members undergo an induction workshop shortly after being elected.



- Board members have the opportunity to sit on Board committees as well as various working groups from time to time.
