

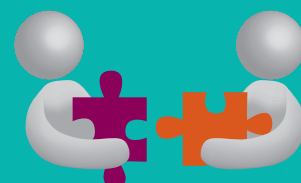


DO YOU KNOW A CARER OF SOMEONE APPLYING FOR NDIS SUPPORTS?

Carers of people eligible for National Disability Insurance Scheme supports are often unsure how to effectively navigate the NDIS.



If you know carers who could benefit from additional help with how best to support the person they care for with their NDIS application, Carers Australia can assist.



We can put carers in contact with others who have successfully helped the person they care for to receive appropriate NDIS supports. Those carers with prior experience are happy to share their knowledge so that carers new to the NDIS can feel more confident with the application process.



This service will complement the existing system and reduce the need for service provision staff to field carer-related questions.

Conversations take place via phone or in person.

All administration is done by Carers Australia and we will cover any out of pocket expenses.
